A7SS MODEL CYLINDER BARREL -- Part No. 67-1310

This cylinder barrel originally made available for 500cc Twin Competition machine engines has a heavy base section and is bored out .040" or 1 MM oversize.

It can be used on a 500cc as it is, and can be bored out to 70 MM and used when building a "Short Rod" 650cc engine.

Parts required to convert a standard A10SR Super Rocket engine to a 650cc Short Rod engine:
