1962 METALLIC RED AND BLUE IN SPRAY CANS.

Since introduction of the Royal Star 650 and 500 models, many dealers have requested that we supply this metallic enamel in spray cans. Now it is available from our stock.

Application of these metallic enamels is a three-coat process.

1. Apply Aluminum Undercoat Primer.
2. Apply Gold Undercoat for Metallic Red, or, Apply Chrome Aluminum Undercoat for Metallic Blue.
3. Apply the Red or Blue finishing coat.

These refinishing materials can be applied over the original enamel, providing this is cleaned and sanded according to the instructions on the "Sprayon" containers.

It must be understood that since the finishing coat is semi-transparent, a good, smooth finish on the undercoat is of top importance in obtaining a good job.

IMPORTANT. Read and follow the instructions on the "Sprayon" cans. These will tell you how to prepare the surface, and how to use the materials for best refinishing work.
