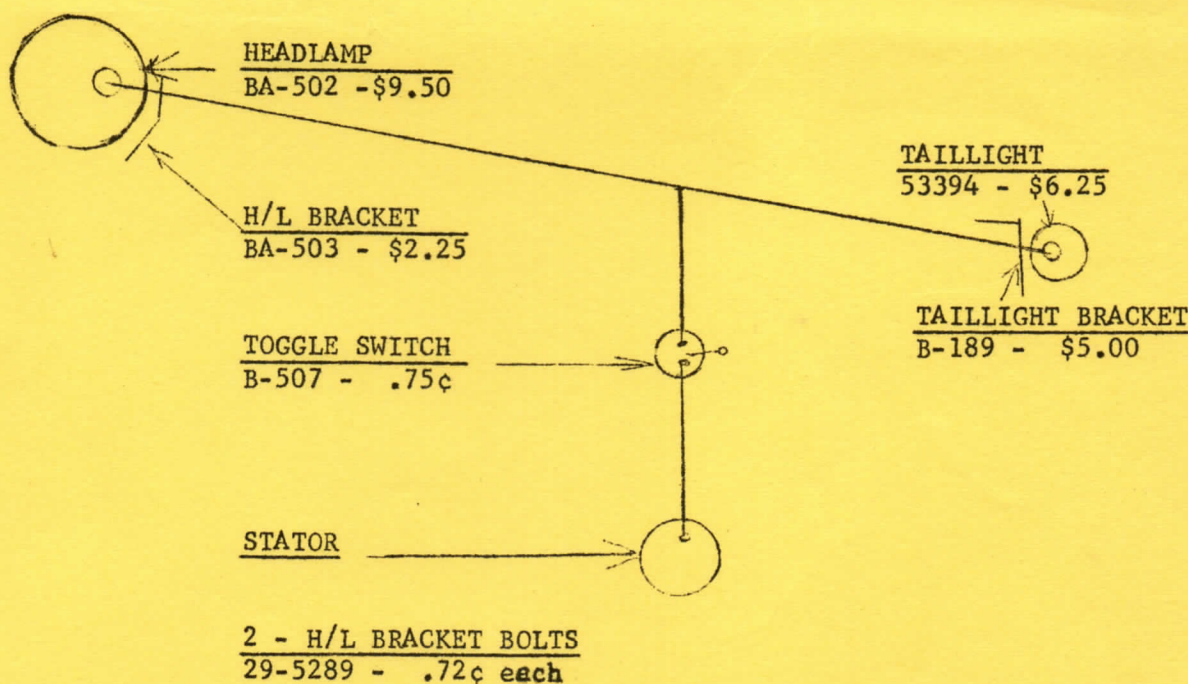
DIRECT LIGHTING FOR THE D7 TRAIL BRONC

The electrical output is between 6 and 7 volts with a circuit load of 29 to 30 watts at an engine speed of 6000 r.p.m. This voltage range is well within the capacity of a standard 6 volt bulb.

It is best to use a 32/30 candle power headlamp bulb as there will be less chance of blowing bulbs. The standard automotive type bulbs - headlamp G.E. #2330 and taillamp G.E. #81 are recommended.

When only a headlamp and taillamp are desired, they may be wired up as per diagram below:
