

## A MODELS - ENGINE MOUNTING.

To improve engine mounting, the fixing studs have been replaced by bolts as indicated in the sketch.

Self-locking nuts are employed, and plain washers are fitted beneath the bolt heads and the nuts, except in the case of the front engine bolt, No. 42-4469, which retains two spring washers and special nut, Part No. 67-1292.
