ANNOUNCING..... NEW BSA FACTORY SCHOOL FOR MECHANICS, AND FIELD SERVICE CLINICS

Admission Limited, And Only By Appointment

We are very happy to announce that starting on January 8, we will conduct a series of Factory Service Schools for MECHANICS here at the BSA Factory Branch in Nutley, New Jersey.

This series of Factory Mechanic Schools will be under the direct supervision of Walter Brown, BSA Incorporated Service Manager, who has had many years of experience in this field.

INSTRUCTOR FROM BSA FACTORY IN ENGLAND. A trained instructor, Mr. Len King, from the BSA Factory Service School in Birmingham, England will conduct these five day schools. Mechanics will receive exactly the same courses as presented at the Factory in England.

BENCH WORK. At these Nutley classes, every mechanic will get actual bench work, under close supervision, and will be able to tear down, service, and rebuild BSA engines, gearboxes and ignition systems under expert direction.

SERIES OF CLASSES. Classes at Nutley will be limited to twenty mechanics at a time, in order that every student can receive personal attention as needed. We will conduct four classes during the month of January.

5-DAY SESSIONS. Each class at Nutley will have a 5-day session of intensive instruction, Monday through Friday.

SERVICE CLINICS. Three 3-day Field Service Clinics will be held during February in Ohio, Illinois and Georgia. Mr. Len King will also conduct these Service Clinics. Latest service shop practices and repair procedures will be explained and demonstrated.

WHO WILL BE ELIGIBLE? BSA dealers will certify their full-time mechanics, and **ONLY FULL-TIME MECHANICS EMPLOYED BY BSA DEALERS CAN ATTEND.**

Dates of Mechanics School Classes and dates and locations of Service Clinics will be sent to you in the immediate future along with full details and application forms.
