LOCTITE Sealant, a product of the American Sealants Co., 705 No. Mountain Road (Newington) Hartford 11, Connecticut, is described in the informational bulletin enclosed together with a listing of distribution points. This product is highly recommended for dealer shop use. In point of fact, it is used in many places in the original factory assembly of new motorcycles, serving often in the place of conventional lockwashers or as an additional safety guard in addition to lockwashers.

The cost is nominal, the uses many. A drop or two can firm a bearing housing that has become loose in a casting, can assure that a nut will not come loose or back out, or can seal-off a leaking joint. In some applications, it has been used in the place of safety wiring. Field reports indicate it to be a most useful product in the elimination of loose bolts and nuts that cause service problems.

RAM COTE leather and plastic dyes for saddle tops are described in the enclosed folder. A product of RAM COTE, 1139 West 69th St., Chicago 21, Illinois, these dyes have been used by many dealers for altering the color of saddle tops, refurbishing saddle tops on used machines, etc.

Dealer reports indicate it to be completely satisfactory from a service standpoint, non-streaking and non-smearing, and that new saddle tops refinished cannot be told from the original finish.

It has an especial value in the refinishing of used saddle tops in adding value to used machines with smeared or faded saddles.
